



Instruction on the Minimum Salary Threshold Upon Reaching the Age of 45 for Subsequent Residences as a Skilled Worker

For the initial issuance of a resident permit for skilled workers under Section 18a or Section 18b of the Residence Act, the salary must generally correspond to at least 55 percent of the annual contribution assessment ceiling in the German governmental pension insurance, if the applicant has reached the age of 45 (Section 18 Paragraph 2 No. 5 AufenthG).

This also applies if the stay as a skilled worker follows a qualification measure pursuant to Section 16d of the Residence Act or an opportunity card pursuant to Section 20a of the Residence Act.
